[6 points] The sound of a jet engine during aircraft take-off, measured at a distance of about 50 meters from the engine, is given by its sinusoidal sound pressure function $P(t)$, in Pascals (Pa), where t is the time in seconds after the plane enters the runway. The sound pressure reaches its maximum of 60 Pa at $t = 0$ seconds, and the smallest positive time where it reaches its minimum of 20 Pa is $t = 1/40$ seconds.

a. [3 points] Find a formula for $P(t)$.

- b. [3 points] Given that the sound pressure function is 50 Pa at $t = 1/120$ seconds, find all t -values where $P(t)$ is equal to 30 Pa within the first 0.1 seconds.
